

Guidelines for Poster Presentations

In order to prepare your poster presentation please be aware of the following:

1. The Poster Format will be a maximum of 120 cm high by 90 cm wide. Please ensure that your poster is either less than or equivalent to these measurements.
2. All posters will be shown in the “Salão Nobre” room from 5.30 pm to 7 pm on Wednesday, 3rd October 2018, and Thursday, 4th October 2018. Please consult the programme to find out the session for your poster.
3. All posters must be handed in at the registration desk from 8 am to 1 pm on Wednesday 3rd October 2018, in a tube clearly marked with your name and the number of assigned Poster Session (1 or 2). EUSARF staff will put up the posters before the sessions. Posters can be collected from the registration desk again on 5th October.
4. Each poster should clearly include the title and name of the author(s) and affiliation.
5. For maximum impact, your poster should include captioned illustrations, photographs, graphs or other types of visually appealing materials. Please, do not simply lay out the text of your abstract as a “poster”.
6. During the Poster Sessions, the participants will move about from poster to poster, so the text on the poster needs to be kept to a minimum and large enough font to be read from at least 1m away.
7. Attendance at the poster Session: At least one of the authors must be present during the poster session, in order to briefly present it (5 minutes) and answer questions from other participants. These Sessions offer an ideal opportunity for disseminating information about your study and for networking with those interested in similar and other studies.
8. Certificates of Poster Presentations will be handed out to the presenters at the end of each Poster Session. No certificates will be given to presenters who do not attend the Poster Session.
